Guidance on the privacy of personal data

1. Privacy

Vincent Tractors Ltd ("We", "Company") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.

Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. We recognise the importance of keeping that information secure and letting you know what we will do with it. For the purpose of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) the data controller is Vincent Tractors Ltd of Fraddon, St Columb, Cornwall (registration number GB 132 1795 83).

2. What is this Privacy Policy for?

This policy applies to Vincent Tractors Ltd and the trading companies as detailed via this web page: www.vincenttractors.co.uk. If you leave our site via a link or otherwise, you will be subject to the policy of that company/website provider. We have no control over that policy or the terms of the website and you should check their policy before continuing to access that site.

The policy sets out the different areas where user privacy is concerned and outlines the obligations & requirements of the users, the Company and website owners. Furthermore, the way this website processes, stores and protects user data and information will also be detailed within this policy. This policy also covers the privacy of the information provided throughout alternative interaction via (but not limited to) face to face, telephone and email.

3. Contact & Communication

Your personal information is kept private and stored securely until a time it is no longer required or has no use, as detailed in the EU General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR.

When contacting Vincent Tractors Ltd (or a segment of the company as detailed in the link in the introduction) we may request some personal details to ensure that we can provide you with the best possible service and result of the contact made. This may include, but is not limited to:

- First and Last Name
- Title (Mr, Mrs etc.)
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Company name (if applicable)
- Business registration number (if applicable)
- Your home/work address
- Payment information
- Vehicle details (if applicable)
- Working times/times you will be available for a visit

On some occasions, we also receive information from the manufactures we work with. We may be provided with information by our manufacturers when a service/product is requested to be delivered by Vincent Tractors on their behalf.

4. The Website

This website and its owners take a proactive approach to user privacy and ensure the necessary steps are taken to protect the privacy of its users throughout their visiting experience. This website complies to all UK national laws and requirements for user privacy. This website is aimed solely at users who access it from the UK mainland.

We keep certain basic information when you visit our website and recognise the importance of keeping that information secure and letting you know what we will do with it. Every effort has been made to ensure a safe and secure form to email submission process but advise users using such form to email processes that they do so at their own risk. This website and its owners use any information submitted to provide you with further information about the products/services they offer or to assist you in answering any questions or queries you may have submitted.

5. Email Newsletter

Vincent Tractors Ltd operates an email newsletter program, used to inform subscribers about products, services and company news. You will only be subscribed to our newsletter should you manually subscribe or make a request direct to someone at the Company or through your enquiry.

Subscriptions are taken in compliance with UK Spam Laws detailed in the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003. All personal details relating to subscriptions are held securely and in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR. No personal details are passed on to third parties nor shared with companies/people outside of the company that operates this website.

Email marketing campaigns published by this company or its owners may contain tracking facilities within the actual email. Subscriber activity is tracked and stored in a database for future analysis and evaluation. Such tracked activity may include (but not limited to); the opening of emails, forwarding of emails, the clicking of links within the email content, times, dates and frequency of activity. This information is used to refine future email campaigns and supply the user with more relevant content based around their activity.

In compliance with UK Spam Laws and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 subscribers are given the opportunity to un-subscribe at any time through an automated system. This process is detailed at the footer of each email campaign. If an automated un-subscription system is unavailable clear instructions on how to un-subscribe will by detailed instead.

6. Use of Cookies

This website uses cookies to better the users experience while visiting the website. Where applicable this website uses a cookie control system allowing the user on their first visit to the website to allow or disallow the use of cookies on their computer / device. This complies with recent legislation requirements for websites to obtain explicit consent from users before leaving behind or reading files such as cookies on a user's computer/device. Cookies are small files saved to the user's computer(s) or device(s) hard drive that track, save and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the users with a tailored experience within this website. Users are advised that if they wish to deny the use and saving of cookies from this website on to their computers hard drive they should take necessary steps within their web browsers security settings to block all cookies from this website and its external serving vendors.

This website uses tracking software to monitor its visitors to better understand how they use it. This software is provided by Google Analytics which uses cookies to track visitor usage. The software will save a cookie to your computer(s) or device(s) hard drive in order to track and monitor your engagement and
